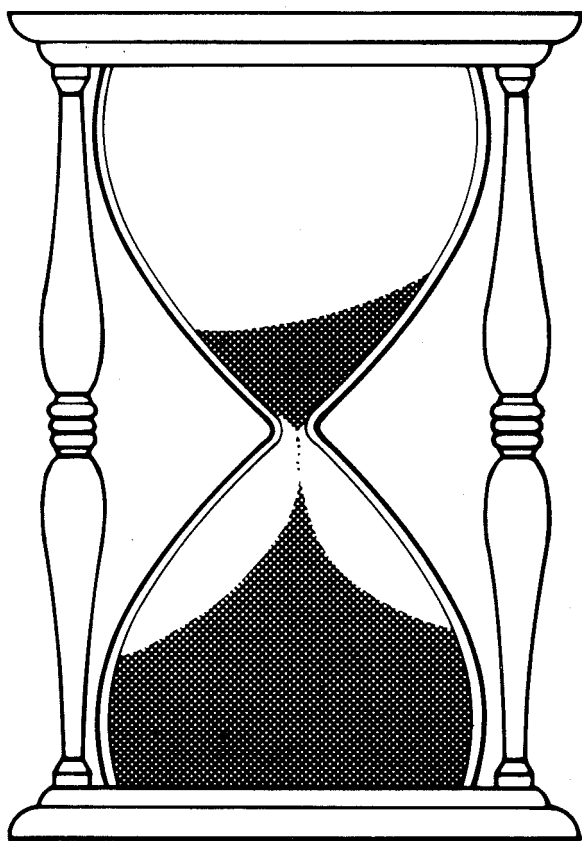

PREFACE

Considerations of time and space have made it impossible to compile a properly definitive catalogue of the Fordham Collection. What follows is thus more a check-list than a catalogue, simply indicating author, title, place and date of publication for each individual item. To facilitate the Collection's use, however, some attempt has been made to categorise its diverse contents - firstly, according to country or continent and secondly, according to type of work. The latter task presented numerous problems, not least because Fordham himself was somewhat uncertain on the issue. Inevitably, the categorisation that has emerged is not without its brand of idiosyncrasy, but what matters most, of course, is that it is internally consistent.

The compilers are indebted to the staffs of the Library and the Map Room of the Society for their patient assistance in what proved to be an irksome, though not unrewarding task.

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CATALOGUE NOTES

The following notes are intended as a guide to the use and interpretation of the catalogue:

Location of catalogue items - All items marked with an asterisk are to be found in the Society's Map Room. The remainder are housed in the Society's Library.

Cataloguing procedure where no author given - In cases where a work has no clearly identifiable author, the compiler's or publisher's name has been substituted. The term 'Anonymous' has been used normally only where a work has no clearly identifiable author, compiler or publisher.

Cataloguing procedure where more than one work bound together - Where several works are bound together, separate entries are always given.

New impressions - With few exceptions, no attempt has been made to distinguish between different states of particular editions. Anyone desiring information of this nature should examine the inside covers of the works in question, where Fordham often made pencil notes to this effect.

Map scales - Map scales have been given only where they are specifically stated in the map titles.

Categorisation by type of work - Works have been categorised as road-books, topographies, etc. not by virtue of title or of the inclusion of a single category of material (the case in Fordham's classification of road-books), but rather on the basis of the history and purpose of their production. Hence a work containing road-maps and route distances but deriving from a personal 'tour' is placed under tourist guides and itineraries, whereas a work with similar contents but deriving from a specific commission is categorised under road-books.

Further information - Invaluable aids to the catalogue are to be found in some of Fordham's publications, especially *The Road-Books and Itineraries of Great Britain, 1570 to 1850* (Cambridge, 1924). A number of Fordham's personal, annotated copies of these publications are available as part of the Fordham Collection (F83).
